# Club Competitions

## **Saturday Competition**

Members will be permitted to play as a two ball.

## **9 Hole Competitions**

- These are held on a Tuesday and Thursday during the months of May, June, July and August
- Qualifying Competition
- £30 for the league winner each month

# Club Competitions

## **Sunday Competitions**

- Davidson Cup equivalent for the Sunday competitions
- Stroke scores will not count towards the Summer League as the computer will not report the stableford score.
- Extend the Campbell McCleave to allow members playing on the Sunday to return a score

# Club Competitions

#### **Scratch Series**

- Best three gross from five competitions
  - Scratch Matchplay Qualifier
  - Walker Cups
  - Edgar Scratch Cup
  - Captains Day
  - Presidents Day

#### **Club Masters**

All members will play at the same time.

## Order of Merit - Golfer of the Year

- Double Order of Merit Points for Captains Day and Presidents Day
- Sunday and Wednesday counts towards Order of Merit
  - 1st 15 points | 2nd 10 points | 3rd 5 points
- Matchplay Winners in the singles, pairs, scratch get 40 points
- Matchplay Finalist in the singles, pairs, scratch get 20 points
- Matchplay Semi Finalist in the singles, pairs, scratch get 10 points
- Bank Holiday competitions count towards Order of Merit
  - 1st 15 points | 2nd 10 points | 3rd 5 points

## New Handicap Categories

- Club and disability handicaps have been retired
- 36 is the maximum initial handicap allotment for men
- New Category 5
  - 28.5 36.4
- Category 6
  - 36.5 54.0

## **CONGU Changes**

## **Supplementary Scores**

 Relaxation of the rules to allow an unlimited number of score submissions per year and removal of the restriction of one per week. However, the restriction on Category 1 players will remain in place.

## **Qualifying Scores**

 Confirmation that cards submitted for Initial Handicap Allocation are included in the definition of Qualifying Scores for handicap purposes. Accordingly a player whose handicap is allocated on the basis of such submitted scores under Clause 16 will automatically be allocated a Competition Handicap status.

## Local Rules 2018

#### Out of Bounds [Rule 27]

- Beyond any fence or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course
- 8<sup>th</sup> Hole
  Over the hedge between the 8<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> fairways
- 10<sup>th</sup> Hole
  On or over the burnt line on the left hand side of the fairway
- 13<sup>th</sup> hole
  Over the hedge between the 8<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> fairways
- 14<sup>th</sup> Hole On or over the burnt line on both sides of the fairway
- 15<sup>th</sup> Hole
  On or over the burnt line on the left side of the fairway
- 18<sup>th</sup> Hole
  Raised area as marked on the left hand side of the fairway
- 18<sup>th</sup> Hole On or over the road behind the 18<sup>th</sup> fairway and hole

A ball that crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

## Local Rules 2018

## Integral Parts of the Course

- The raised ground around the base of the trees on to the left-hand side of the seventh fairway
- The stone wall surrounding the tree in the middle of the ninth fairway
- The overgrown path on either side of the twelfth fairway are integral parts of the course.

#### **Paths**

All other paths are obstructions.

Course Guide

#### General

- All areas of long grass are in play and the ball must be found.
- All paths apart from the twelfth are NOT integral parts of the course.
- All winter tee boxes are immovable obstructions
- All water hazards should be clearly marked; if there is any doubt please seek clarification from a member of the Match & Handicap Committee. If they cannot be contacted without undue delay, a ball is deemed to be in the water hazard if it lies where the ground starts to break / slope down to the hazard.
- Grass cutting boxes are integral parts of the course.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Hole

- Flower Beds are GUR
- The burn crossing the 1<sup>st</sup> should be marked as a water hazard as there would be no undue delay in a player dropping behind the hazard and the stakes should continue along the line of the hazard until it reaches the hedge.
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard on the lefthand side of the fairway
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard at the back of the green
  - If a player can't drop within 2 club lengths not nearer the hole, then they should proceed under stroke and distance.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Hole

- Flower Beds are GUR
- The burn crossing the 1<sup>st</sup> should be marked as a water hazard as there would be no undue delay in a player dropping behind the hazard and the stakes should continue along the line of the hazard until it reaches the hedge.
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard on the lefthand side of the fairway
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard at the back of the green
  - If a player can't drop within 2 club lengths not nearer the hole, then they should proceed under stroke and distance.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Hole

- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard running up the left-hand side of the fairway
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard on the right-hand side of the fairway

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Hole

- There should be red stakes defining the lake at the left-hand side of the green as a lateral water hazard
- There should be red stakes defining the lateral water hazard that runs up from the second and then along the path between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> holes

### 4<sup>th</sup> Hole

Flower Bed at back of tee box is to be treated as GUR

## 5<sup>th</sup> Hole

Wooden sleepers defining the Ladies tee box are immovable obstructions.

#### 6th Hole

- There should be yellow stakes defining the lake at the front of the green as a water hazard
- There should be red stakes defining the lake at the left-hand side of the green as a lateral water hazard

### 7<sup>th</sup> Hole

- The raised ground around the base of the trees on to the left-hand side of the seventh fairway is an integral part of the course.
- The Flower Bed at the back of the green and the beds located either side of the gate to the 8<sup>th</sup> Tee are to be treated as GUR

#### 8<sup>th</sup> Hole

- The old putting green [8a] is a wrong putting green.
- Over the hedge between the 8<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> fairways is out of bounds

## 9<sup>th</sup> Hole

- The tree surrounded by the stone wall is an integral part of the course.
- The drain to the left-hand side of the should be marked as a lateral water hazard.
- The raised ground to the right-hand side of the green is NOT a flowerbed.

#### 10th Hole

- Although the boundary wall is man made it defines the out of bounds there is no free relief.
- The lake and drainage ditch must be marked with red strakes to define it as a lateral water hazard. The toilet, hut and the stone wall are immovable obstructions
- The all the ground to the left-hand side of the tee box and behind the hut are integral parts of the course.

#### 11th Hole

 The drainage ditch at the left-hand side of the fairway should be marked with red stakes to define it as a lateral water hazard.

#### 12th Hole

- The barked are in front of the middle tee box is NOT a flowerbed.
- The overgrown path on either side of the twelfth fairway are integral parts of the course

## 13<sup>th</sup> Hole

Over the hedge between the 8<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> fairways is out of bounds

## 14<sup>th</sup> Hole

On or over the burnt line on both sides of the fairway is out of bounds

## 15<sup>th</sup> Hole

 On or over the burnt line on the left-hand side of the fairway is out of bounds

#### 16th Hole

Flower Bed at front of tee boxes is to be treated as GUR.

## 17<sup>th</sup> Hole

- Ditches on left and right and side of the fairway should be defined as lateral water hazards using red stakes
- Lake should be defined as a water hazard using yellow stakes
- Raised area including the Winter Tee box is to be treated as an immoveable obstruction.

#### 18<sup>h</sup> Hole

- Flower Bed at back of tee box is to be treated as GUR
- Ditches should be defined as lateral water hazards using red stakes
- Lake at the front of the green should be marked as a water hazard using yellow stakes.
